If **Propagated by Exhibitor** check box for yes.

If **Propagation Card** is complete check box and attach. Must be attached to qualify for special award.

Check box if **Key Card** is attached. A Key card must be attached for an entry with more than one **plant**.

Describe **Growing Conditions**: e.g., greenhouse, windowsill, artificial lights, outdoors, exposure to natural light

Leave **Judges' Comments** blank

Check boxes for **Eligible Awards** for this entry.
